1. B C A K L R B A E



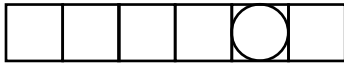
Clue: *This big animal eats a lot of different types of food including berries, vegetation, and fish.*

3. Y E C T O O



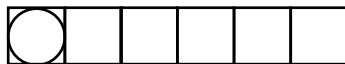
Clue: *This is a wolf-like animal that howls.*
