1. VIERR RTOTE



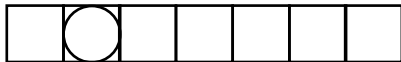
Clue: *This cute animal is a really good swimmer and slides down riverbanks and on ice.*

2. UEIPORNCP



Clue: *This animal is covered in ~30,000 quills.*

3. COCOARN



Clue: *This animal looks like it has a "mask" on its face and is known for getting into trash cans.*

4. MUOPSOS



Clue: *This animal is actually a "marsupial" which means that they nurse their young in pouches (like kangaroos).*

5. NCPIKHMU



Clue: *This small, reddish-brown animal with black and white stripes likes eating nuts.*

Bonus: This semi-aquatic rodent is a great swimmer and is similar to beavers in that they create lodges, though primarily from cattails not trees.
